WSR Tours

Thursday, September 5, 2024 – all day tour! Snoqualmie Falls & Salish Lodge / Woodinville Wineries/Alki Beach – \$90

Depart the hotel at 9 am arriving at the falls with time to walk to the viewing/photo area. Those that feel like a hike head to the bottom of the falls for additional photo ops. There is a great gift shop and



lounge in the lobby if people want to rest and grab a coffee. Will be about an hour stop.

Then it's on to **Woodinville** – Arrive 11:30 a.m. (2-hour stop). <u>Lunch is on your own</u>. There are several restaurants, all within walking distance, and a variety of choices for lunch. Following lunch, you will have time to visit several wineries on the Wine Walk. You can participate in tastings on your own. The tasting fees are waived if you buy a bottle of wine. There are no additional fees.

Last, we head for **Alki Beach**, the birthplace of Seattle. The guide will provide a history of the area and how it grew. There will be photo ops of the City and Puget Sound. Returning to hotel by 4:30-5:00 p.m.

Friday, September 6, 2024, Half day tour to Seattle - \$70

The Hiram Chittendon Locks connect Lake Washington and Lake Union to Puget Sound. There is a Botanical Garden to visit if you choose. After watching the locks move boats from lake level to sound level, we will work our way to the fish ladders. The ladders help to move returning salmon up to the lakes and streams above the Sound. The bus will pick us up on this side of the locks. A guide will have helped to move the passengers to the pick-up point. Board the bus and then off to Pike Place Market.



Next Stop – Experience the History and Culture of the **Pike Place Market**

The passengers will disembark and roam the Market to see flying fish, beautiful flowers, and craftsmen of every kind. Great shopping. If they wish they can grab lunch at one of the hundreds of eateries or one of the delicious bakeries, treats available from multiple sources!

Everyone needs to seek out the gum wall. Make sure you are chewing so you can leave your mark. Following the Market, we will enjoy a city tour on our way to the hotel.

This tour offers a glimpse of Seattle's history. The guide will share not only history but the cultural richness of the city as we travel through various sections of the city. Photo ops throughout the tour. Returns to hotel by 2 pm.
