Vases – we are collecting old vases to donate with bouquets of flowers to assisted living homes.



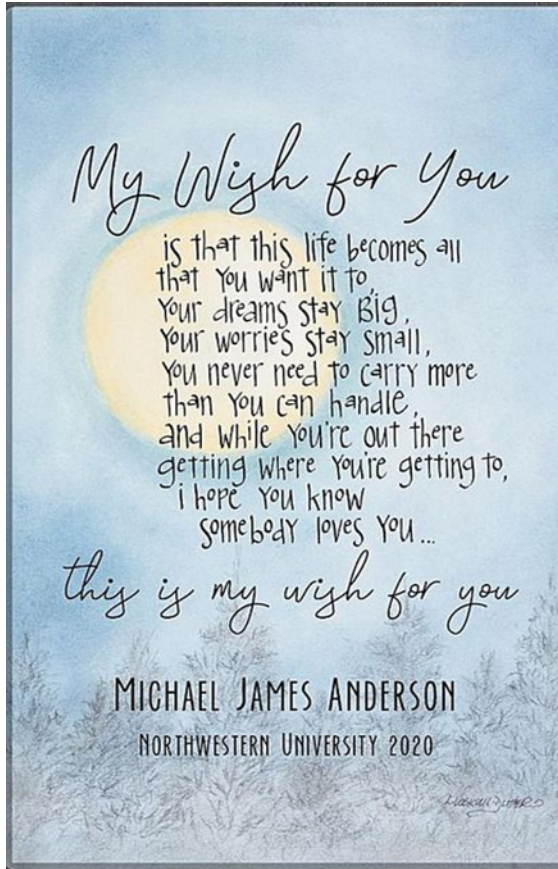
Bingo Prizes- We are collecting bingo prizes for Canterbury Manor and Pinewood Manor.
